## **ThunderCloud Subs Turkey Trot features**

- A five-mile run, one-mile walk, and a Kids K
- 20,000-plus participants from 49 states
- 600-plus dedicated volunteers
- A kids activity tent and moonwalk
- Raffle prizes, live music, large photo cutouts, and more

## **Proceeds**

One hundred percent of the proceeds from the ThunderCloud Subs Turkey Trot go directly to Caritas of Austin—a nonprofit organization that provides housing, employment, education, and food services to more than 20,000 homeless, working poor, and documented refugees in Travis County.

## **Achievements**

- Donated nearly \$3 million for Caritas of Austin over the past 25 years
- Last year alone, raised \$295,000 for Caritas of Austin
- Emerged as Texas' largest five-mile run, growing from just 600 participants in 1991 to more nearly 20,000 participants in 2015
