



A TRIBUTE TO TOM PETTY AND THE HEARTBREAKERS





The Story of Brian Sharp, #1

This year's bib #1 runner will be Brian W. Sharp (follow his journey @laggerheadwalker on Instagram). We're so inspired by Brian's story, dedication, and resilience. He was diagnosed with a severe form of juvenile arthritis at age 24, and has dealt with many ongoing health issues in the 30 years since.

This year was a particularly tough one, but it seems that NOTHING can keep Brian down. This year will be his 14th Thunder-Cloud Subs Turkey Trot.

His first Trot in 2010 was a pivotal moment, when he seriously began his fight against arthritis. After that experience, "I knew I had found an active sport that could be part of helping me in my fight," Brian says. "The ThunderCloud Subs Turkey Trot became the foundation for who I am today, a warrior and fighter to live my best life."

At age 54, he's completed 144 runs (of all distances including four marathons) and traversed almost 11,000 miles.

"My fight against arthritis will never end, which is why it is so important for me to stay as active and healthy as possible, and to always remind myself of the words that (famed long-distance runner) Deena Kastor said in the film 'Spirit of the Marathon'—Sometimes the moments that challenge us the most, define us."
